### **AmCham Hosts Breakfast Meeting with U.S. Congressional Delegation**

ULAANBAATAR, Mongolia - The American Chamber of Commerce (AmCham) in Mongolia hosted special members-only breakfast meeting, sponsored by its member Wagner Asia Equipment LLC, on May 29th, 2016 featuring the U.S. Congressional Delegation led by the Honorable Peter Roskam and the Honorable David Price, Her Excellency Jennifer Zimdahl Galt, U.S. Ambassador to Mongolia and His Excellency Bulgaa Altangerel, Ambassador of Mongolia to the U.S.

The meeting convened over 50 participants including executive leaders of AmCham members and representatives from the U.S. Embassy in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia who discussed and exchanged ideas to promote and bolster the U.S. – Mongolia bilateral relationship with the members of Congress.

Her Excellency, Jennifer Zimdahl Galt, U.S. Ambassador to Mongolia noted during her remarks that, "I am convinced that U.S. Government efforts – in conjunction with the efforts of U.S. private investors and companies and partners like AmCham Mongolia – can and will play a significant part in enhancing Mongolia's economic vitality, which will in turn help strengthen its democracy and hence its stability."

The Honorable Peter Roskam, Congressman and Chairman of the House Democracy Partnership said, "Mongolia is becoming a true role model for other Asian Nations on how great democracy can be."

"We have a great desire to partner with Mongolia and help them to succeed," said The Honorable David Price, Congressman and Ranking member of House Democracy Partnership, during his speech.
