### ERNST & YOUNG MONGOLIA LLC RENOVATES THE THIRD CENTRAL HOSPITAL CARDIAC SURGERY DEPARTMENT'S CHILDREN'S ROOM

The Cardiac Surgery Department of UGTE performs an average of 250-350 open heart surgeries per year, half of which are pediatric heart surgeries. The department performs 98 percent of the pediatric heart surgeries performed at state hospitals.

The department lacked a comfortable inpatient environment and some medical supplies, so Ernst & Young furnished the inpatient room for children undergoing surgery. The project included the installation of vacuum windows and doors, bacteria-resistant linoleum flooring, a child-friendly sink, and cheerful wall decor. To meet the needs of doctors, diagnostic tools such as pediatric pulse **oximeters**, thermometers, and stadiometers were provided, as well as cots, children's dining tables and chairs, humidifiers, room temperature thermometers, tablets, and toys for patients.

### GOLOMT BANK IS COLLABORATING WITH GUREN ACADEMY TO IMPROVE THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE SKILLS OF 400,000 STUDENTS



The Global Nomad project has been implemented to improve the English language speaking skills of 400,000 students in grades 6-12 across Mongolia with the help of artificial intelligencebased technology.

Golomt Bank, a supporter of education, became a project partner in November 2022. As the project moves forward with the signing of a cooperation agreement, all bank employees are eligible for international quality training courses prepared by Guren Academy.

In the first phase of the project, 2,861 English teachers received training. Now, the second stage of the project is underway, with student registration and selection for the program on the Astrid application.

Golomt Bank finances various projects and programs within the framework of its social responsibility, especially to support education.

The Global Nomad works to meet the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals and the goals of the Government of Mongolia's Vision 2050 long-term development program.

## HERBALIFE NUTRITION RECYCLES 3.3 TONS OF PLASTIC BOTTLES AND 1.4 TONS OF CARBOARD TO HELP DECREASE WASTE GENERATION



Herbalife Nutrition has made minimizing its impact on the environment one of its top goals and has implemented many initiatives at the multi-stakeholder level. Herbalife has set a goal of reaching zero carbon dioxide emissions from its factories, warehouses, and offices by 2050. Herbalife cooperated with the Tuvshinsaikhan Industry Waste Recycling Center from 2016 through 2020. A total of 3.3 tons of plastic bottles and 1.4 tons of cardboard boxes were recycled and avoided landfills. Tuvshinsaikhan appreciated the project and praised its waste management solutions. Building on its success in green development, Herbalife is working to create a sorting and receiving facility for product packaging at its Saruul Center warehouse and distribution center this year. The CASA program implemented by the Herbalife Family Foundation has successfully implemented 150 programs in 56 countries since its establishment in 1995. The program's main goal is to improve children's nutritional environment, provide knowledge about proper nutrition, and improve their education. The program works with non-profit children's welfare organizations.




The CASA program officially launched in Mongolia in October 2022 in cooperation with the Veloo Foundation. Herbalife donated 15,000 USD and plans to donate 20 million MNT this year. The donation will be used to prepare nutritious meals for children, improve their dining environment, and improve the kitchen. So far, 40 percent of the donation goal has been achieved by collecting eight million MNT from the company's Independent Members.

## KHAN BANK EMBRACES NEW WORKPLACE MODES, ENABLING EMPLOYEES TO WORK IN-OFFICE AND REMOTELY



Since its establishment, Khan Bank has aimed to conduct environmentally friendly activities and now integrates the 17 Sustainable Development Goals into its operations. A prime example is Khan Bank Tower, a green office with a modern building management system that can safely withstand a magnitude eight earthquake. The management of Khan Bank, one of the nation's largest employers with more than 6,500 employees, started a new model for work-life balance at its Head Office this year.





Khan Bank regularly implements projects to ensure a sound work-life balance for its employees, adopting timely new trends in labor relations. A recent survey of Khan Bank Tower employees determined the number of employees who can work remotely, leaving around 70 percent of employees working in the office. Khan Bank has approved flexible work arrangements for eligible employees, dividing positions into fully remote, occasionally remote, and fully working in the office.

Employees now have the opportunity to work flexibly and remotely from home or from the 12th to 20th floors of Khan Bank Tower, which are now shared office spaces for their use.



## THE KHAN BANK FOUNDATION LAUNCHED THE 2022 WOMEN'S DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

For the 2022 program, nurses and caregivers who work for the well-being and health of the population were given the opportunity to refresh their knowledge.



There are 36,118 teachers working in 859 general education schools nationwide in the 2022-2023 school year, and 82 percent of them are women.

The Khan Bank Foundation emphasizes that this year's program will be implemented for women secondary school teachers who provide general academic knowledge and basic education to Mongolia's future leaders.

Teachers who want to participate in the Women's Development Program must have more than one year of teaching experience, fully commit to participation, be willing to devote time to the program, and have a sincere desire for self-development.

Registration was held through March 22, 2023. A total of 120 selected participants will choose from personal development, English language, financial education, psychology, health, and aesthetic training for two months in a combination of classroom and online training.

### MSM GROUP DONATES TOOLS TO RAJIV GANDHI POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE OF PRODUCTION AND ART



MSM Group LLC has donated Proxxon power tools and personal protective equipment (PPE) to the Rajiv Gandhi Polytechnic College of Production and Art.

The college is the sole college in Mongolia providing certified vocational training to students in the field of traditional wooden doll making. We believe the donated tools and PPE will greatly contribute to the

accessibility of professional and advanced tools for students.

#### MSM GROUP EMPLOYEES DONATE BLOOD TO THE NATIONAL BLOOD TRANSFUSION RESEARCH CENTER

MSM Group LLC and the National Blood Transfusion Research Center (NBTRC) organized a blood donation day to encourage social responsibility.

More than 60 employees donated blood, and the blood and blood products collected will reach more than 190 people in urgent need of transfusions.



#### BE HUMAN | MSM GROUP AND SHAMBALA2056 PROJECT COLLABORATION CONTINUES



MSM Group LLC has supported and collaborated with the Shambala2056 project on the BE HUMAN campaign. Since 2021, 572 trees have been planted, with 286 trees planted in Erdene soum, Dornogovi Province, an area with heavy desertification and soil degradation. Another 286 trees will be planted in Uliastai, on the outskirts of Ulaanbaatar.

The 286 trees donated by MSM Group LLC are growing on the letter "A" of the "BE HUMAN" land-art project, an installation of planted trees that can be seen from the sky. As of the end of 2022, these trees have absorbed 1.3 million kg of carbon dioxide, produced 2.1 million kg of oxygen, and generated 7.2 million kg of biomass, improving the soil and the area's overall environment.

#### MSM GROUP DONATES MNT 25,000,000 TO MISHEEL KIDS FOUNDATION

MSM Group LLC has donated 25,000,000 MNT to the Misheel Kids Foundation to support the foundation's rural dental treks, which provide accessible dental care to underprivileged children in Mongolia.

Misheel Kids Foundation is a non-governmental organization that provides free dental treatment and services to children in rural areas without regular access to dental care and children from low-income groups in Ulaanbaatar.

in its accessible dental care trekking campaigns, which traveled to rural areas in the far west of Mongolia, through co-sponsorship and providing Mercedes-Benz, Ford, and Jeep vehicles for the journey.
